Our station name is punctuated by the word 'Access' and our schedule is punctuated with groups of people and organisations that elsewhere would seldom get five minutes of airtime; much less the

chance to produce and present a daily radio programme. People with intellectual difficulties from the Menni organisation, as well as older members of our communities produce and broadcast their own programmes on a daily basis. We have time dedicated to the Irish language, we provide access and training to transition year students from local schools and we actively promote local bands and performing artists who, in some cases, go on to produce programmes that provide yet another platform for the arts.

Liam is a highly experienced director and producer of a range of specialised programmes, for community radio, in particular Sound and Vision schemes - Realizing Your Dream & Follow the Band (Round 5) as Production Assistant. He has also produced Slam Dunk-Lucan Hedgehogs Special Olympic Club (Round 6), Travellers on the Move (Round 8) and has produced Dublin 15 – My Story (Round 9) and has worked on producing Dublin 15 – My Story (Round 10) and Rub-A-Dub Dub(Round 10), Executive Producer on Young at Heart (Round 10) for Phoenix FM and as Producer on West Dublin Community Festival (Round 12). Liam has considerable experience in outside broadcasting, producing a number of live outside broadcasts for both Phoenix Fm and Liffey Sound Fm. He has also worked on a number of 'one-off special' programmes for Liffey Sound FM, Phoenix Fm and West Dublin Access Radio in both production and editing. Liam is Station Manager in West Dublin Access Radio.
