Meeting of the Serbian and Macedonian delegation

<u>Mr. Milos Nikac</u>, Senior Adviser to the Director from the Republic Fund for Pension and Invalidity Insurance of Self-employed, Serbia and Montenegro, opened the meeting by welcoming the participants. He reminded them that Speaking Days on Social Security were organized in the past, but since 1991 Serbia and Montenegro had not organized such kind of activity. He informed the participants that Mr. Mihovil Rismondo, Croatian expert on pension and invalidity insurance will present the idea of the Speaking Days, Croatia is the only one of the former Yugoslav republics that continued with this practice. Mr. Nikac underlined the importance of the Speaking Days and stated that if the Speaking Days are successful, then further activity can be taken in order to organise Speaking Days between Serbia and Montenegro and Bosnia and Herzegovina and later with Croatia (as was proposed by Mrs. Mirjana Mirkov, Director of the Department for implementation of pension and invalidity insurance, Republic Fund for Pension and Invalidity Insurance of Employed, Serbia and Montenegro). He suggested that when the CARDS Social Institutions Support Programme is over, the countries themselves can take up the responsibility of organizing such events.

<u>Mrs. Mirjana Mirkov</u> welcomed the participants and apologized that Mr. Goran Lončar, Director of the Republic Fund for Pension and Invalidity Insurance of Employed couldn't attend the meeting due to negotiations on governmental level. She expressed her hope that the Speaking Days on Social and Health Insurance will be organized with the other Balkan countries as well because co-operation exists, but still, it needs to be improved and the Speaking Days could be great tool for improvement of the co-operation and setting up a network of experts dealing with social security issues.

Mr. Rismondo, Executive Co-ordinator, Croatian Pension Insurance Institute, Croatia, informed the participants about the Croatian experience in organizing Speaking Days with Austria since 1980. He stated that one of the goals of the Speaking Days is to accelerate the procedure of acquiring rights in problematic cases. The second goal is providing information – a certain percentage of the people coming to the Speaking Days are not yet eligible for pension, but they want to know the procedure in advance. The experts themselves also exchange information regarding changes in the regulations and they usually exchange lists of unsolved cases. The Speaking Days do not change the bilateral agreement but depending the outcome, if there is need, than both sides can agree on certain changes in the agreement. He recommended that people working on the Speaking Days are experienced practitioners, preferably inspectors, legal officers, independent advisers because they need to be able to work and solve problems independently. He also mentioned that it's normal to have higher number of people interested in the Speaking Days in the beginning, and than the number will gradually drop, although it will keep oscillating as newly insured people come to the pensionable age.

<u>Mr. Aco Janevski</u>, State Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Social policy, "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia", expressed his support of the idea to organize Speaking Days between the SISP countries and expressed his hope that if the results are satisfying, than this type of event will continue to be organized.

Afterwards, the participants were divided in working groups for the following day (one Serbian and one Macedonian expert per group) and were given application forms to be filled for those participants that will require further investigation regarding their case.

The participants from both delegations exchanged information regarding the problems they have encountered in certain cases, as well as about the recent changes in the regulations.

Speaking Days - practical work

(Overview)

The experts for Pension and Health Insurance were working with clients from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 until 16:30. Out of 84 people interested in the free legal advice, 64 people showed up (Appendix I).
