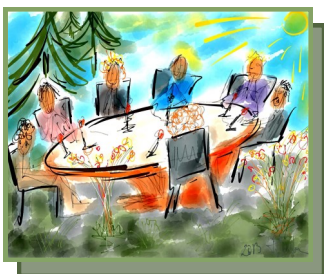

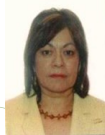

This event takes place in the framework of the first Summer School of the Pestalozzi Programme of the Council of Europe organised in cooperation with the Academy of Bad Wildbad. The Summer School will take place every year from now on and replaces the training seminars jointly organised since 1978 (a total of 134).

Under the overall title "Understanding Diversity" about 80 education professionals from all over Europe will have the opportunity to follow a wide range of workshops. This opportunity for professional development and exchange also seeks to network education professionals within the community of Practice of the Pestalozzi Programme: a community which promotes the values and principles of the Council of Europe in the everyday practice of education and offers a space for the professionalisation of European education practitioners within and for our diverse societies.

The main working language of the Summer School is English, with courses also offered in German and in French.
