Further to the adoption of Resolution 1582 (2007) on "Parliaments united in combating domestic violence against women": Mid-term Assessment of the Campaign on 5 October 2007, the Parliamentary Assembly encourages national parliaments to organise events around the "International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women" (25 November 2007) and during the "16 Days of Activism against gender violence", until 10 December (International Human Rights Day).
